## **Is A Gas Line Right-Of-Way On Your Property?**



**How to tell:**

Look for line markers, and evidence of clearance of trees.

The deed to your property, property plat, or subdivision layout map should show utility lines and their right-of-ways.



**What it Means:**

A past owner of the property made an agreement with the gas company.

There is a gas line buried on your property.



**What else you must know:**

Right-of-ways usually grant the gas company the right to ingress and egress to maintain and repair their lines. This is for everyone's safety!

Right-of-ways vary in width. Most are 50' wide, or 25' from center of the pipe to each side.

No trees, bushes, parallel fences or buildings or structures may be placed on the right of way.
